



BRIDGE LOCK INSTRUCTIONS


SWITCHING THE CX-5 CBE SIGHT FOR USE WITH THE MATHEWS ARCHERY BRIDGE-LOCK SIGHT MOUNTING SYSTEM


1. Remove the windage adjustment lock knob as shown in figure 1 and 2.







2. Using a 9/64th Allen, remove the two screws that hold the upper windage clamp in place as shown in figure 3 and 4.







3. Flip the windage clamp over and reinstall the screws in the farthest left set of holes on the elevation mount as shown in Figures 5-7.










4. Using a 1/16 Allen, remove the two screws that connect the windage bar to the sight housing as shown in Figures 8 and 9.







5. Flip the windage bar so that the lower windage clamp is now on top as shown in Figure 10, then reinstall the screws so the assembly looks like Figure 11.







6. Reinstall the windage lock knob on the bottom as shown in Figure 13.





Your CBE CX-5 Sight is now ready to be attached to the Bridge-Lock sight mounting and will have full windage adjustability.





7. When the Bridge-Lock compatible set screw is tightened onto the sight bar, you will notice that the set screw does not line up with the indents on the bar as shown in Figure 14. The set screw will still securely lock the bar in place. It is recommened that you mark the bar either at the front or back of the riser (Figure 15) so that it can be easily reinstalled if removed.
